


HARDWARE - BIOMETRICS/FINGERPRINT READERS

All software packages in the law enforcement and corrections space need to integrate with hardware that makes operations more efficient. To that end, ATIMS has integrated barcode readers, signature pads, biometrics (fingerprint readers) and mugshot camera capabilities into its JMS software, including extensive experience with Fulcrum biometrics (now part of Fujitsu America).

Biometrics/Fingerprint Readers: ATIMS provides Biometric integration, which allows each inmate to be biometrically registered within ATIMS via Fingerprint authentication. Additionally, staff can be biometrically registered for login and verification throughout the system. We have designed a system for identification at intake, tracking and release that captures the inmate's fingerprint for easy and accurate identification. Biometrics can be used for inmate self service capabilities as well. See ATIMS Jail Management Software document for details about ALL of the software's capabilities. ATIMS will only procure biometrics for an Agency as part of an ATIMS JMS implementation.

As most Agencies can procure hardware directly from the manufacturer at a much better price point, ATIMS is rarely asked to procure the hardware on their behalf. However, as we do work with many hardware manufacturers in the corrections arena, we have access to pricing and typically provide per piece pricing to help with budgets and will coordinate procurement if that's helpful to the Agency to include it in the JMS contract. We typically have the Agency procure the hardware but we can work with the manufacturer directly if that



makes it easier to include within the contract. All warranty and installation are handled between the Agency and the manufacturer directly. Pricing for the specified peripheral hardware will be provided in the lot sheet.
