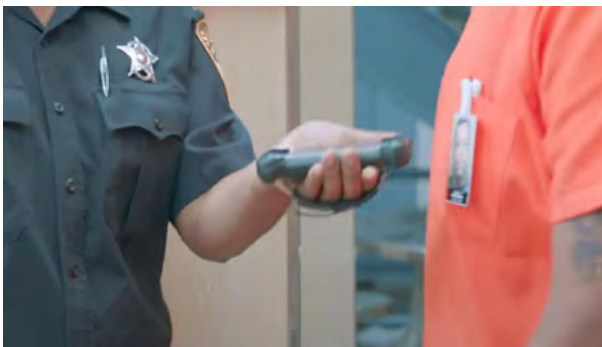
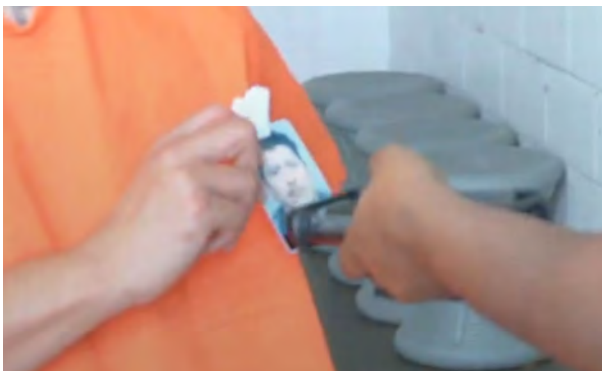

RFID CARDS

RFID plastic badges often result in a lower replacement rate than wristbands, and support larger mugshots to see identifying information from greater distances.

TRANSFERABILITY

ID cards aren't secured to each inmate, making it theoretically easier for them to be passed between individuals. However, this isn't the biggest challenge to ID cards. The biggest challenge about ID cards is forgetfulness. When this happens, court transports, meal offerings, recreation time, etc. can be interrupted by inmates having to go back to their cells to grab their ID Card first.

To overcome issues of exchanging and losing ID cards, facilities can implement policies that discipline non-complying inmates. Jails may deny commissary, visitation, or programs to inmates without an ID card. Having clear consequences encourages inmates to be responsible with their cards.

WRISTBAND USAGE

ID cards are often the preferred method of inmate identification for sentenced inmates, as well as juvenile detention facilities. They are also frequently adopted by jails when their inmate identification is influenced by state's department of corrections' use of inmate identification.
