RFID WRISTBANDS

RFID wristbands enhance security and point-of-contact identification and activity logging. Economical and easy to use, RFID wristbands are difficult to remove and swap.

FASTEN AND FIT

Laminated wristbands contain inmate specific information and RFID tags, and are secured with a metal or plastic fastener. When secured properly with a "handcuff tight" fit, wristbands are not easily transferable between inmates.

TRANSFERABILITY

Clear policies on the transferring or attempting to transfer of wristbands can significantly decrease the frequency of wristband removals and exchanges between inmates. Often, Jails will charge offenders for damaged wristbands, and deny commissary, visitation, and outdoor recreation to inmates who don't have a wristband or were caught exchanging. Clear consequences and loss of privileges encourage inmates to follow your rules.

WRISTBAND USAGE

Wristbands are more commonly used by county jails than prisons or juvenile facilities. The useful life of wristbands pairs with the average length of time pretrial adult offenders remain in custody. Pre-trial offenders do not always require longer-lasting forms of inmate identification.
