Comprehensive General Liability (occurrence form), limits of liability \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence for bodily injury property damage to include Premises/Operations; Products, Completed Operations and Contractual Liability. Contractual Liability and Contractual Indemnity (Hold harmless endorsement exactly as written in "insurance requirements" of specifications). General aggregate \$3,000,000.00
- ✓ 3. Automobile Liability - \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence - owned/non-owned/hired automobiles included.
- 4. Excess Liability - \$_____.00 per occurrence to follow the primary coverages.
- ✓ 5. The NCSA must be named as an additional insured on the liability policies, and it must be stated on the Certificate of Liability (*Please provide a pdf version of the Certificate to NCSA*).
