May 17, 2019

This was a very short week for activity at the General Assembly, and as you can see this is a very short Weekly Legislative Report.

There really was only minimal activity on Wednesday and Thursday before legislators who were in town headed home. Looking ahead to next week, there does not seem to be a lot of activity scheduled so far, but of course that could change at any moment. Much of the activity going on this week is behind closed doors with the Senate leadership working on their version of the State budget bill.

This is definitely the “lull before the storm” and once the budget gets finalized and sent to Governor Cooper for his consideration, everybody will be working frantically to get finished up for the Session.

The House and Senate both adjourned on Thursday and are scheduled to reconvene on Monday evening.

[HOUSE BILL 130](#), Allow Game Nights, which is summarized in the February 15, 2019 Weekly Legislative Report, has been approved by the General Assembly and has been signed into law by Governor Roy Cooper with an effective date of June 1, 2019.

[HOUSE BILL 544](#), NCAMC/NCACC Special Regis. Plate, which is summarized in the April 5, 2019 Weekly Legislative Report, has passed the House and has been sent to the Senate for consideration.
