Weekly Legislative Report

July 30, 2021

Much like the last couple of weeks, this week has been quiet at the General Assembly. While some key House members tasked with finalizing a budget are in their offices and in meetings crunching the last numbers, some legislators are attending the 48th annual American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC) conference in Salt Lake City, Utah.

ALEC promotes itself as a “premier meeting of policymakers committed to free enterprise and individual liberty.” Lieutenant Governor Mark Robinson was a speaker at the conference on Wednesday of this week. While no one knows exactly how many legislators are attending this year’s conference, it is enough of the membership to allow both the House and Senate to hold mostly non-voting sessions this week.

The House and Senate adjourned on Thursday and will reconvene on Monday, August 2.
