Weekly Legislative Report

October 15, 2021

As we all begin to enjoy the first few weeks of fall with changing leaves and a hint of changing weather, the only things that are changing at the General Assembly are the legislative maps being prepared for the next election.

This week added to the already lengthy period of time legislative watchers have been waiting on a budget. However, the lack of legislative activity provided the opportunity for legislators involved in redistricting to weigh-in on what the re-drawn districts in our State should look like.

Since our General Assembly is a part-time legislature, meaning many members have full-time jobs back home in their districts, some have chosen to use this slower pace to attend to their jobs and to also meet with constituents. Others have taken this opportunity to catch up on things in their legislative offices.

The House and Senate adjourned on Thursday and will reconvene on Monday, October 18th.
